Data Privacy Policy

1	<p>The Committee of the Welford and Weston Local History Society holds the following personal data on its members:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Name• Address• Telephone number• Membership status (if paid for current year)• Email addresses (in most cases) <p>The Committee members and Website/Database Administrators are the only people who have access to this data.</p>
2	<p>We use this data to inform you about Society meetings, outings organised by the Society and any other local history events that are likely to be of interest to members. This use constitutes a “legitimate use” under the new regulations and therefore does not need your specific consent. Consent is assumed when you give us the personal data.</p>
3	<p>What we will not do is pass any of your personal data on to any other organisation, nor use it for any other purpose than the above.</p>
4	<p>If, at any time, the committee decides that more data should be held, then your specific consent will be sought before collecting or using such data.</p>
5	<p>We will keep your data for as long as you remain a paid-up member of the Society and for a further two years afterwards in case you wish to revive your membership.</p>
6	<p>At any time you can ask to see the data we hold on you and amend it as required.</p>
7	<p>If you have any complaint about the way we use your data, you have the right to contact the Information Commissioners Office.</p>
